At the April meeting of Just Energy for All, Ilka Vega introduced the session and there were three guest presenters: Adrienne Rice, Founder of Sustainable Georgia, Oscar Villalobos from the DC area Green New Deal formed in 2022, and Karen McElfish from the Virginia Conference. Without going into too much detail, I wanted to mention just a few items.

As I mentioned in the last article, we need to understand that Social Action includes much more than just "Climate Change." That being said: "What"? Yes, we are interested in the effects of climate change, but let's think broader. Climate JUSTICE includes things like Racial Justice, Housing Regulations, Indigenous Peoples Rights, Economic Inequity, etc. To get back a little to Energy, HOW do we transition from an Extractive Economy to a Regenerative Economy? must: Shift economic control to communities, Democratize wealth and the workplace, Advance ecological restoration, Drive racial justice and social equity, Relocalize most production and consumption, and retain and RESTORE cultures and traditions.
